

## AKIRA CLOUD (34).zip !NEW!

I'm a fan of the unzip command line utility that ships with macOS. I give it a .zip file and it unzips it for me. No flags or arguments to remember (for my typical usages anyway). Most importantly, I've fully internalized the unzip command into muscle memory, probably because of its *perfect mnemonic*. I tried a bunch of iOS apps, but wanted no friction, no tracking, no cloud, no social, no analytics, no account, etc. so eventually built Flat Habits (flathabits.com). Also wanted to own my habit data (as plain text), so I made sure Flat Habits stored its data locally as an org file. My previous post mentioned *quickly adding new tasks and searching existing ones* as Plain Org's driving goals. Of course, neither of those are as useful without automatic cloud syncing, so plugging into iOS's third party cloud support was a must-have. No personal data is sent to any server, as there is no server component to this app. There are neither third party integrations, accounts, analytics, nor trackers in this app. All your data is kept on your iPhone, unless you choose a cloud provider to sync or store your data.
