The smart algorithm learns from corrections you make to the transcribed text. This means the more you use the software, the more accurate your results become. The software also memorizes patterns, and commonly grouped words when you speak, to predict which words are most likely to occur. This acts as an extra boost to your speech recognition accuracy. You will want to pick a software that offers auto-digitizing if you do not want to digitize the design yourself from the .png or .jpg. Hatch 3 is my favorite of the bunch for that. However, auto-digitizing has a lot of limitations, and you cannot usually convert complicated .jpg or

.png files well. (Basically, auto-digitizing is best for simple designs with a minimal amount of colors.) If you want to digitize anything more complicated, you will need to manually create the design, which any of the listed digitizing software will let you do.

I recommend doing the free trials for the software and seeing how the auto-digitizing works for your images before purchasing anything, though.
