

How to Watch Pearl Harbor (2001) in High Definition for Free

Pearl Harbor is a 2001 American epic war film directed by Michael Bay and starring Ben Affleck, Josh Hartnett, Kate Beckinsale, and Alec Baldwin. The film depicts the events of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, and the subsequent American involvement in World War II. The film was a box office success, grossing over \$450 million worldwide, but received mixed reviews from critics, who praised the action sequences and visual effects, but criticized the historical inaccuracies, romance, and dialogue.
