How to Use Testmode GGV1322 for Pioneer AVIC-F900BT/XS/RE

Testmode GGV1322 is a tool that allows you to access the service mode of the Pioneer AVIC-F900BT/XS/RE navigation system. This mode can be useful for troubleshooting, testing, or modifying the device settings and features. However, it is not intended for casual users and may cause damage or malfunction if used improperly. Therefore, you should only use it at your own risk and with caution. How to Enter Service Mode with Testmode GGV1322

2. Extract the zip file and copy the "TestMode" folder to the root directory of your SD card.
3. Insert the SD card into the slot of your Pioneer AVIC-F900BT/XS/RE device.
4. Turn on the device and wait for it to boot up.
5. Double-click on the touch panel directly to activate Testmode GGV1322. You should see a message saying "Test Mode Activated" and a watermark in the lower-right corner of the screen.
6. You are now in service mode and can access various test functions and settings.

How to Exit Service Mode with Testmode GGV1322

To exit service mode with Testmode GGV1322, you can simply turn off the device and remove the SD card. Alternatively, you can follow these steps:

1. In service mode, press the "Menu" button on the touch panel.

- "Factory Reset": This allows you to reset your device to factory default settings. Be careful as this will erase all your personal data and preferences.
