- 2. Extract the trainer file using a software like 7-Zip. Some trainers may require a password to unzip, which is usually "trainer".
- 3. Run the trainer as administrator and then run the game.
- 4. During the game, press the keys indicated by the trainer to activate the cheats. For example, F2 to activate the trainer, NUMPAD1 for immortality, NUMPAD2 for super accuracy, and so on.
- 5. Enjoy the game with your new abilities!

Note: The trainer may be detected by your anti-virus software as malware, but this is usually a false alarm. You can disable your anti-virus temporarily or add the trainer to the exception list. Also, some trainers may not work with online or multiplayer modes, so use them only for single-player or offline modes.But what makes Black Ops II different from other Call of Duty games? The answer lies in its innovative gameplay features, such as branching storylines, Strike Force missions, and futuristic weapons and gadgets. These elements add a new layer of depth and replayability to the campaign, as well as challenge and variety to the combat. Branching storylines mean that your actions and choices have consequences that affect the outcome of the story. You may have to decide whether to kill or spare a target, rescue or abandon a teammate, or complete or fail an objective. These decisions can lead to different endings, as well as unlock new missions or paths. For example, if you manage to capture Menendez alive, you will unlock a secret ending that reveals his true plan. If you fail to protect the president in one mission, you will have to deal with the aftermath in another. Strike Force missions are optional side missions that let you control a squad of soldiers and drones in a sandbox-like environment. You can switch between first-person and overhead views, and give orders to your units using a tactical map. The missions have different objectives, such as defending a base, escorting a convoy, or sabotaging an enemy facility. The missions are also affected by your performance in the main campaign, and vice versa. For example, if you fail to stop a cyberattack in one mission, you will face more enemy drones in a Strike Force mission. The missions are also dynamic and unpredictable, as the enemy AI can adapt and counter your strategies. Futuristic weapons and gadgets are another highlight of Black Ops II. The game features a range of advanced technology that gives you an edge in combat, such as optical camouflage, wrist-mounted grenade launchers, quadrotor drones, and more. You can also customize your loadout before each mission, choosing from different weapons, attachments, perks, and equipment.
