The No. 3 Xavier Musketeers (27-9) head into a Sweet 16 matchup against the No. 2 Texas Longhorns (28-8) on Friday at 9:45 PM as the NCAA Tournament continues live from T-Mobile Center and airing on CBS. The Cougars, who were the betting favorite to win it all entering the NCAA Tournament, are aiming to earn a third consecutive Elite Eight berth -- accomplished once in the program's history, the Phi Slama Jama era -- but the Hurricanes stand in their way and are not expected to go quietly. Creighton finished atop the ACC regular-season standings in what was a down year for the league, and it now fights alone as

the only team left in the second weekend among conference members. The Hurricanes squeaked past No. 12 seed Drake in Round 1 and dominated No. 4 seed Indiana in Round 2, setting up a showdown between two of the hottest teams in the field on Friday night from Las Vegas. Hurricanes guard Isaiah Wong looked sharp, dropping in 27 points in addition to eight rebounds. Meanwhile, Princeton looked every bit the tournament favorite in an 81-64 win over Auburn to advance to the Sweet 16 stage as guard Tramon Mark led the way with 26 points along with nine boards. A couple stats to keep an eye on: The Hurricanes rank 18th in the nation when it comes to field-goal percentage at 48.10% on the season. The Cougars, however, have been holding their opponents to a field-goal percentage of 36.10%, which places them first in the country. We'll see which of these strengths -- offense or defense -- will win out. have allowed to their opponents (44.7%). Princeton is 21-0 when it shoots better than 44.7% from the field. The Hurricanes are the 134th-ranked rebounding team in the nation, while the Cougars sit at 14th.The Cougars score only 3.3 more points per game (74.9) than the Hurricanes give up (71.6). When Princeton scores more than 71.6 points, it is 22-0. Creighton Stats Insights The Hurricanes' 48.1% shooting percentage from the field this season is 12 percentage points higher than the Cougars have given up to their opponents (36.1%). This season, Creighton has a 24-4 record in games the team collectively shoots better than 36.1% from the field. The Hurricanes are the 134th-ranked rebounding team in the nation, the Cougars sit at seventh. The Hurricanes' 79.1 points per game are 22.5 more points than the 56.6 the Cougars allow.Creighton has a 17-2 record when allowing fewer than 74.9 points.Princeton Home & Away ComparisonPrinceton is posting 77.3 points per game this season when playing at home, which is 1.7 more points than it is averaging on the road (75.6). When playing at home, the Cougars are surrendering 6.5 fewer points per game (54.4) than on the road (60.9). At home, Princeton is draining 0.9 fewer treys per game (7.9) than when playing on the road (8.8). It also sports a worse three-point percentage at home (34%) compared to in road games (39.3%). Creighton Home & Away ComparisonIn 2022-23 Creighton is averaging 8.2 more points per game at home (83.4) than away (75.2). At home, the Hurricanes concede 72.9 points per game. Away, they concede 69. Beyond the arc, Creighton sinks fewer treys away (7.2 per game) than at home (8.3), and shoots a lower percentage on the road (35.3%) than at home (39.3%) as well. For the second game in a row, the Longhorns will have its NCAA Tournament game broadcast live on CBS. According to Texassports.com, Jim Nantz, Bill Raftery, Grant Hill, and Tracy Wolfson will call this game between Texas and Xavier on CBS on March 24. On defense, Kennesaw State relies on havoc creation, including a 19.6% turnover creation rate and a 10.5% steal rate for the season.

Xavier commits a live-ball turnover on 9.9% of possessions on offense, and Kennesaw State also closes possessions well with a 74.2% defensive rebound rate in 2022-23.
